Pre-Rosh HaShanah announcements:

As in previous years, Rabbi Avi Taylor is scheduled to be the Chazan for Rosh HaShanah and Yom Kippur. Our honored residents Rabbi Shlomo Freidman and Eliyahu Tannis will also be contributing chazzanim. Rabbi Shmuel Abenson, an expert sofar blower, will be the ba'al tokeah for both days.

This year, we will distribute the sheets sooner, and intend to schedule a workshop in each language in order to explain the system, and to help interested residents to prepare the sheets for use during the prayers.


